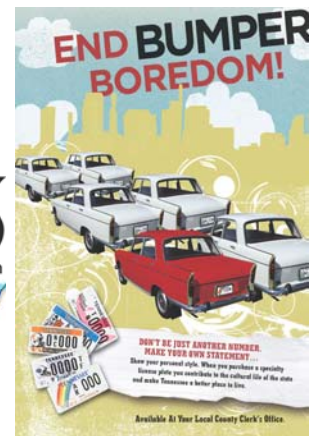

- Classes will be held during the month of July

Drop off and Pick up

Students may be dropped off at 9:45 each morning. Classes will start at 10am. We will end the day by 2pm, and students should be picked up no later than 2:15. If you are running late, please call ahead to let us know.

Lunch

Students will need to bring a sack lunch with them. We will break for lunch around 11:45 for about 30 minutes. If your child has a food allergy let us know in advance. Students like to share food and we will be able to watch for this.



Drawing- This week will cover topics in Pen & Ink drawing, Graphite, and Charcoal. Students will learn basic techniques and advance as their abilities allow. The final project for this class will be a detailed still life. (age 7-12) **July 11th - 15th**

Watercolor- Topics covered will include color theory, Washes/resists, Artists/history, Landscapes, abstracts, etc. (age 7-12) **July 18th- 22nd**
