So, come, have fun and experience a new level of freedom in your work by painting on YUPO without brushes!!! YUPO is like skating on ice; exciting and exhilarating, a loose paint application with found "tools" which can result in a vibrant, dynamic painting.

Elizabeth's workshop is designed to connect to the inner, intuitive, right-brain artist in you via abstract expressionism.

Don't paint in abstraction? Participants don't have to be abstract enthusiasts to enjoy this workshop. It's a great opportunity to support your TN Art League as well as learn a new painting technique.

Judy Klich grew up in North Carolina with a love of nature and being outdoors. She seeks to find a spiritual relationship to the natural world and capture earth's essence and beauty in her paintings. There is energy to be harnessed within the delicate balance of life, death and rebirth. Through constant searching for a spiritual connection to earth led her to painting abstracts with a primary theme of nature and organic shapes.

After exploring many mediums, Judy fell in love with Encaustic paint which allows for endless exploration and amazing possibilities. It is a combination of painting, drawing, collage and sculpture and the mixture of beeswax, dammar resin, oil paint and heat is naturally spontaneous. Encaustic dries quickly, giving an immediate satisfaction, yet it can be reworked over and over allowing for continuous creativity.

Judy is a graduate of the University of North Carolina at Greensboro and is currently working on her M.F.A. She lives in Nashville with her husband and two young children. Judy teaches encaustic painting workshops to adults through Plaza Art and Harpeth Art Center. Through teaching she hopes to bring her love of painting to others and a sense of connection to the earth through nature as inspiration.
