



Tennessee Art League Gallery Store Consignment Agreement
for TAL Members

This consignment agreement made this _____ day of the month of _____ in the year of 20____ is between the Tennessee Art League (known as consignor in this agreement) and _____ (known as the artist in this agreement).

The Artist has created and does rightfully own and possesses certain works of art and desires to sell same; and the Consignor desires to sell the artists work and in that consideration each party agrees to the following terms and considerations as specified as follows:

Terms and Conditions:

- 1) Consignor shall sell the consigned works for a retail price as determined by the Artist. The Artist shall receive 75% of the asking price as established on the inventory sheet/form.
- 2) Net payment of commissions payable to the Artist will be mailed by the 10th of the month.
- 3) The Artist shall submit and initial inventory sheet/form of items being sold. Each piece of inventory shall be labeled with tags of appropriate standard. The standard for this tag shall be as the example AAA### (That is the Artist's 3 initials and 3 digits unique inventory number for each item in the gallery store.) and the Retail Price.

Inventory sheets/forms should include the following:

Artist's Name • Mailing Address • Phone Number(s)

Itemized Inventory sheets/forms should include the following for all items in the Gallery Store:

Date • Inventory Number • Brief Description • Retail Amount
Any subsequent submissions shall include the same.

- 4) The type of work being submitted for consignment is:

- 5) Artwork must be design and craftsmanship quality standards. Consignor will jury all pieces and reserves the right to accept or reject pieces from the Artist. The Artist will conform to the following standards:

- All work must be original, in good taste and made by the artist
- All work must be in good condition and ready to sell
- All wall art must be framed in proper hangers
- All hanging fasteners shall be securely attached and reinforced
- All work shall be clean a free of chemicals or other contaminants
- Any artwork requiring specific display stand must be furnished by the artist

6) Artwork should be rotated periodically. Consignor reserves the right to remove a piece of work if it hasn't sold in two months. After 30 days of notification, if the Artist had not retrieved the requested removal of artwork, that piece of artwork becomes property of the Consignor. The Artist will have the right to remove items as needed after an item has been in the Gallery Store for a minimum of two months. If an item or items are removed by the Artist, the Consignor request that a replacement item be placed in the Gallery Store.

7) Consignor shall not be liable for any injury or loss that happens to the undersigned, his/her merchandise from any cause whatsoever, including loss or damages that may be caused by customers. All consigned works shall be safely displayed to the best of the Consignor's ability. The Artist should maintain own insurance for damaged merchandise.

8) In the event that the premises are destroyed or damaged by fire or other casualty to the extent that the Consignor cannot continue to operate its business and occupy any portion thereof, this agreement shall terminate by and between the parties or agents thereof, all waiver of claim or damages by the Artist or agents thereof shall be binding.

9) The Artist shall protect the Consignor's business name (Tennessee Art League Gallery Store) at 808 Broadway, Nashville, Tennessee by not promoting individual business names. The Consignor may request a biography of the Artist in order to promote the individual Artist and their artistic medium.

10) It is understood by all parties that the terms and conditions of this agreement cannot be changed or modified except in writing, signed by all parties involved.

11) This agreement is non-transferable.

12) Either party with thirty (30) days written notice may terminate this agreement and subsequently all inventory agreements. By the end of that thirty (30) days notice, the Artist or a designated representative shall remove all inventory of that Artist from the premises. Any inventory remaining at the end of the thirty (30) days shall become the sole property of the Consignor.

I hereby acknowledge that I have read and received a copy of this consignment agreement and agree to abide by its terms and conditions.
